#### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Teach a daily LINC class, following LINC Curriculum and PBLA Practice Guidelines
- Develop and maintain a culturally sensitive, welcoming, and pedagogically effective classroom environment
- Use Google Classroom and the Avenue LMS as a regular part of teaching; ongoing tech learning is expected and required (support is provided)
- Prepare modules, lessons and regular assessments in alignment with LINC themes
- Conduct ongoing assessment of students' needs and tailor class content accordingly
- Provide regular, effective feedback on student work
- Monitor students' progress on an ongoing basis, planning course content to address required CLB competencies, and promoting to new CLB benchmarks as they are achieved
- Keep organized, accurate records; e.g., for attendance, assessment results, student progress towards CLB promotion
- Prepare occasional reports as required; e.g. quarterly summary of class progress, challenges and needs; annual Learner Progress Reports
- Attend and participate in meetings with the Language Program Team as well as all-staff meetings
- Read and respond regularly to email and other messages; communicate efficiently and effectively with team members
- Participate in and help with activities of the wider HMC organization; e.g. AGM, Multiculturalism Day
- Perform other duties as required
