6. Terms of Reference (ToR)

Purpose: Strengthen ACSA's systems and staff capacity to prevent and respond to GBV.

Objectives: Policy review, training delivery, toolkit development.

Deliverables: Policy recommendations, toolkit, workshops, final report.

Qualifications: Advanced degree or equivalent, 5+ years GBV/capacity-building experience, facilitation skills,

knowledge of GBA Plus.

- Type: Fixed-term consultancy
- Reporting Line: Senior Manager, ACSA Community Services
- Budget: Up to \$20,000 CAD total, covering the period September 2025 March 2026
- Payment: 30% on work plan, 40% on interim outputs (training/policy drafts), 30% on final toolkit/report
