- Design assessment tasks for ongoing evaluation of learners' progress based on the Canadian Language Benchmarks and PBLA guidelines;
- Adhere to the assigned class schedule and work cooperatively with LINC Supervisor, Program Assistant, and regular teachers to maintain program quality;
